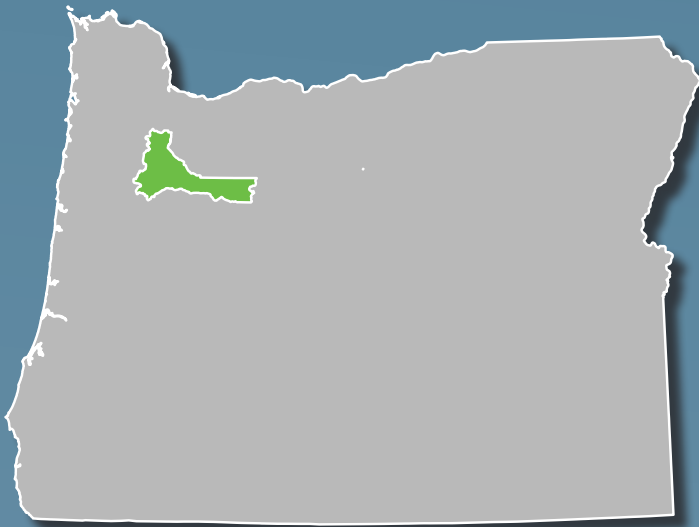


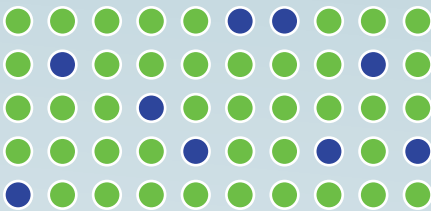
# Teens and Suicide

2018 statistics about youth and suicide in Marion County, Oregon



## Did you know...

- Suicide is the 2nd leading cause of death for those between the ages of 10 and 24 years old in Oregon.
- In 2017, there were 107 deaths by suicide among those 24 years and younger in the state.



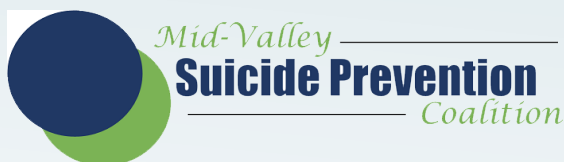
In Marion County, **18%** of 11th Graders reported seriously considering suicide. **8.3%** reported making an attempt.



**19.8%** of Marion County 8th graders reported seriously considering suicide. **10.1%** report making an attempt.
